In March Jim Elliot's Robotics Team, Raptor Force, headed to UC Davis for 3 days of competition. The team had a great time and many new friendships were forged with other teams. Though knocked out in the semifinals, we are proud of their efforts. The team not only kept their robot in the competition but helped 2 other teams rebuild their robots so that they could continue to compete. Not bad for a team that competes against teams with \$300,000 budgets. In April the team went to Atlanta to compete in the international competition. There were teams from 27 countries, 500 robots and 12,000 students. The highlight of the competition for our team was when the Israeli Deputy Consul came to the Raptor Force pit and had her picture taken with the team.
