College Prep....

SENIORS: SAT REASONING TEST –

The deadline to register for the October 10 SAT Reasoning Test is September 9. The December 5 test date is the last date a 4-year college will accept. Register at www.collegeboard.com. Our school code is 051444. SAT Preparation Booklets are available in Mrs. Fox's office.

SAT/PSAT WORKSHOP –

For the first time: if we have 16 students interested we can conduct our own class sessions on our campus - the Delta College SAT Preparation Class - Intensive class taught by a Delta professor. Let Mrs. Fox know ASAP if you are interested. 8 evening sessions. Fee \$150. Be prepared for the NEW Scholastic Aptitude Test (S.A.T.) in this intensive review.

PSAT - Practice SAT

The PSAT will be administered at JECHS on Saturday, October 17, from 8:00 - 12 noon. This valuable practice tool for the actual college entrance exam may be taken by sophomores and juniors. Statistics show that students who have taken this exam score 50-70 points higher on the SAT exam. The cost is \$18 and there are a limited number of spots. Juniors register starting Sept. 21. Sophomores register starting Sept. 24. Payment must accompany the registration.
