## Instructions for access to RenWeb data base for new users

1. Go to website: [www.renweb.com](http://www.renweb.com)
2. Click : ParentsWeb Login (left side in pink)
3. Read “First time user instructions”
4. Put in school ID: JEHS-CA
5. Email address: Put your email address that you gave to us at school.
6. Click on the button: New Parent Login
  - After you click this, it will verify whether or not your email matches with the one you gave us and is in the data base.
  - If the screen says ERROR, please check with us to see if the email address is the right one.
  - If your email address matches what we have, RenWeb will generate a password and send it to you via email.
  - When you have your password from RenWeb, go back to the PARENTS web and do the following.
    1. Put in district code: JEHS-CA
    2. Put in your email address
    3. Put in your RenWeb password
    4. Click parent login



Explore – click on newsletter and downloads. **If you cannot access RenWeb, contact Mrs. Henry so we can resolve the problem before school starts.** You will receive grade reports, report cards and discipline notices via RenWeb.
